Journal Article Databases and Print Subscriptions

The library subscribes to three journal article databases that are specifically targeted to green studies. EBSCO's *GreenFile* provides indexing and abstracting for more than 384,000 items covering the subjects of global warming, green building, pollution, sustainable agriculture, renewable energy, and recycling and points to full-text content for more than 4,700 entries. *Environment Complete*, also from EBSCO, contains full-text content for 680 journals and 120 monographs in such areas as green agriculture, ecosystem ecology, renewable energy sources, pollution & waste management, environmental technology, environmental law, and public policy. Gale/Cengage's *Environmental Studies and Policy Collection* offers wide coverage of environmental issues contained in 200 journals and other publications.

Additional library databases obtained through the *SUNYConnect* and *NOVELny* consortia that contain relevant articles regarding sustainability include EBSCO's *Academic Search Complete* and *Business Source Complete*, and Elsevier's *Science Direct*. A variety of full-text, environmental journals are available from these databases including such titles as *Applied Energy, ASHRAE Journal, BioCycle, Building and Environment, Energy for Sustainable Development, Energy Policy, Environmental Design & Construction, Journal of Environmental Economics and Management, Journal of Sustainable Development, Renewable and Sustainable Energy Reviews, Solar Energy* and *Wind Power Report*.

The library also has print subscriptions to several sustainability journals such as *Environmental Ethics, GreenSource: The Magazine of Sustainable Design, The GreenSpec Directory, Sustainability: The Journal of Record*, and *Yes: The Journal of Positive Futures*.
